They were familiar with the promise God gave to them in Isaiah 11:6, 7:

(6) For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. (7) Of the greatness of his government and peace there will be no end. He will reign on David's throne and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever. The zeal of the Lord Almighty will accomplish this.

They were expecting a great king, greater than King David. Their hope was that a king, who was a political and military leader, would make everything better. We often do the same thing.
