<b>Preterist</b>	Period of Jewish war against Rome (66-70 AD).
<b>Historist</b>	One day = 1 year The true remnant of the church to the time of the reformation.
<b>Futurist</b>	A literal three and one-half years at the end of the Tribulation or to two different periods of that length totaling seven years.
<b>Idealist</b>	Symbolizes the entire church age.
